David James Smith, son of Mary Jane McWilliams and Leonard Smith and step parents John H. Jones and Olga Smith, the middle child to sister Kristen and brother Daniel, was born and raised in Frederick. He was part of a loving and

extended family; he was a caring son, brother, uncle, nephew, cousin, friend, and patriot. David found his love of sports early in life. He began wrestling at age 4 and played basketball throughout his elementary and middle school years. During his high school years at Frederick High, he wrestled, played lacrosse, football, and soccer. He also discovered the world of golf - and it became his most frustrating, but beloved sport.

David's college years included Salisbury University and East Carolina University (ECU). He joined the Marine Corps Reserves in 2003. His first tour of duty was in Iraq in 2006-2007 with the 4th Light Armored Reconnaissance Battalion, Bravo Company of Frederick, Maryland. He returned to ECU after this tour and was working toward a degree in Distribution and Logistics with an anticipated graduation in 2011. In October of 2009, David was deployed to Afghanistan. He was gravely injured on Jan. 23rd, 2010 in the Helmund Provence, and died of his injuries on Jan 26th, in Landstuhl Germany.

David loved life and living it to its fullest. He is remembered for a great sense of humor and an infectious laugh. He had a commanding presence evident to those around him; he cared about everyone in his life, bringing out the best in each of them. The Sgt. David James Smith Memorial Golf Tournament raises funds to support an annual scholarship in David's name for a graduating Frederick High School senior, but mostly supports the needs of our veterans and our local community. At this point in time, over \$248,000 has been issued in grants and scholarships, with an endowment fund established for the scholarships. The funds are administered through The Community Foundation of Frederick County. The tournament is organized by David's family and friends. The Sgt. David Smith Memorial Fund is our way of honoring David and others who served. We know he would be proud.
